### **A wife of noble character who can find?**

She is worth far more than rubies.

<sup>11</sup> Her husband has full confidence in her  
and lacks nothing of value.

<sup>12</sup> She brings him good, not harm,  
all the days of her life.

<sup>13</sup> She selects wool and flax  
and works with eager hands.

<sup>14</sup> She is like the merchant ships,  
bringing her food from afar.

<sup>15</sup> She gets up while it is still night;  
she provides food for her family  
and portions for her female servants.

<sup>16</sup> She considers a field and buys it;  
out of her earnings she plants a vineyard.

<sup>17</sup> She sets about her work vigorously;  
her arms are strong for her tasks.

<sup>18</sup> She sees that her trading is profitable,  
and her lamp does not go out at night.

<sup>19</sup> In her hand she holds the distaff (Tool used for spinning)  
and grasps the spindle with her fingers.

<sup>20</sup> She opens her arms to the poor  
and extends her hands to the needy.

<sup>21</sup> When it snows, she has no fear for her household;  
for all of them are clothed in scarlet.

<sup>22</sup> She makes coverings for her bed;  
she is clothed in fine linen and purple.

<sup>23</sup> Her husband is respected at the city gate,  
where he takes his seat among the elders of the land.

<sup>24</sup> She makes linen garments and sells them,  
and supplies the merchants with sashes.

<sup>25</sup> She is clothed with strength and dignity;  
she can laugh at the days to come.

<sup>26</sup> She speaks with wisdom,

- and faithful instruction is on her tongue.
- <sup>27</sup> She watches over the affairs of her household  
and does not eat the bread of idleness.
- <sup>28</sup> Her children arise and call her blessed;  
her husband also, and he praises her:
- <sup>29</sup> “Many women do noble things,  
but you surpass them all.”
- <sup>30</sup> Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting;  
but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.
- <sup>31</sup> Honor her for all that her hands have done,  
and let her works bring her praise at the city gate.

#### **REBEKAH**

**Mother of Jacob and Esau**

For every mom who has ever had the temptation to play favorites with her children, pay attention to Rebekah.

**BATHSHEBA**  
**Mother of Solomon**

Bathsheba was well-named as it was her “bath-ing” that attracted the attention of King David.

**JOCHEBED**  
**Mother of Aaron, Moses, and Miriam**

Here is a story of not just Moses’s Mom, but Midwives who, in their act of civil disobedience, allowed Moses to be born.

**MARY**  
**Mother of Jesus**

She was the sure thing.

**Dad’s how should we treat Mom?**

**MEN ARE TO THINK OF THEIR WIVES AS THE LORD THINKS OF HIS BRIDE.**

2. Mothers are the emotional backbones of the family. They provide the holding place for everyone's feelings and do their best to keep us from being hurt.

3. Who would kiss your ouch's to make it all better if she weren't around? Mothers have the magic touch (and kiss) to help us heal our wounds, physical and emotional.

4. Truly, our mothers worked hard and made sacrifices, so our lives would be better. There are not a lot of people willing to do that, so let her know you appreciate it.

5. Mothers are forgiving — so forgive her in return. Perhaps nothing will be as valuable a gift to both of you as forgiveness. Open your heart and drop your resentments. Now that's love.

6. When you want to climb the tallest mountain, your mother will fix you a good plate before you go and give you some food to take with you. She is the one who will support your dreams when no one else will.

7. Whether you believe it or not, her boundaries made you a better person. You may not have liked some of her decisions, especially when you wanted to party with your friends, but she did try her best to keep you out of trouble. Look at some of your friends without a mom who cared that much. Where are they now? What are they doing?

8. A mother's ears and eyes hear and see everything. They also have a computer-like memory for all the good (and some of the bad) that came your way. It's nice to have someone with whom you can reminisce about your whole life.

9. Mom taught you to be a functioning adult. That was her job, and without that, making it through the modern world would be very hard. Your mom may have forced you to do your homework, but now you see how important it was.

10. A mother's smile, when it is directed toward you, makes your day a whole lot better. All she needs is to know that she has helped you to be and feel your best.
